Hayoung Koh, who shares the following story in the two ANMC Newsletters, was born in Korea, but followed her parents and went to the mission field at the age of 7. There, growing up as an MK-TCK for 12 years, she had to live in an unfamiliar environment, especially where there was no religious freedom, helping her parents in ministry. She came to Asbury University in Wilmore, Kentucky, the USA to study and major in Elementary Education. Attending All Nations Church, a missional church, Koh shares the feeling inspired by being served through All Nations United Methodist Church and All Nations Mission Center (ANMC) at this most important time in her life that contributes to the Kingdom of God.

Former pastor, but now a missionary, Youngwook Jeon has started the ministry for college students. To help me and my friends, who are lacking in faith, grow more in faith, he has started the Quiet Time group with us, and so far the group continues after the Sunday worship service. I am grateful to those who led me to become a member of the church, not just by attending church, but through one-on-one Bible Study, Quiet Time meetings, and various church services. I thank you for supporting the young people so that they can take one step at a time for the Kingdom of God. Although at first, I felt that the independent life that started without my parents was difficult and daunting, I confess that I can live as a more mature Christian than before by experiencing the grace of being loved, united, and growing in faith through the All Nations Church community.
